**May 16th, 2020 - ernst busch born january 22 1900 kiel germany died june 8 1980 east berlin east germany now berlin germany german actor and singer best known as the leading interpreter of roles created by the dramatist bertolt brecht busch came from a working class family joined the german munist party and took up acting professionally when he lost**
