May 27th, 2020 - the abbey arose from three distinct bases the first was the seminal irish literary theatre founded by lady gregory edward martyn and w b yeats in 1899 with assistance from gee moore it presented plays in the antient concert rooms and the gaiety theatre which brought critical approval but limited public interest lady gregory envisioned a society promoting ancient idealism'
