*April 13th, 2020 - bovine milk fever or parturient paresis is an acute to subacute afebrile paralysis of mature dairy cows that occurs most commonly at or soon after parturition cause milk fever is triggered by a sudden loss of circulatory calcium due to sudden losses into the colostrum and milk serum calcium levels decline from a normal of 8.5-10 mg dl "**milk fever caprine supply***
