May 22nd, 2020 - the isolated and ever dwindling beluga whales of cook inlet one of the smallest distinct populations of marine mammals on the planet should be listed as endangered under the federal endangered species act noaa fisheries announced thursday april 19 only about 300 of the intelligent fish eating whales roam the silt saturated tidal arms of upper cook inlet near alaska s urban center'
